Due to the requirements of the federal Children's Online Privacy Protection Act, the parents or guardians of children under the age of 13 must provide their consent before those children can fill out the award program's online application form.

The application form asks for the applicant's name, street address, telephone number, e-mail address, birthdate, gender, grade, and school; the name, telephone number and e-mail address of the applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s); and details about the applicant's volunteer activities. This information is needed to select, notify and publicize honorees. To provide your consent, please send an e-mail note to [consent@applyists.com](mailto:consent@applyists.com). This note must:

> state clearly that you consent to having your child provide personal information to International Scholarship and Tuition Services for the Prudential Spirit of Community Awards program.

> contain the following information:

- your name
- the name of your child
- the birthdate of your child
- your street address
- your e-mail address
- your child's e-mail address (if he or she has one)
- your telephone number
